Student and Parent Agreement Form

The following principles are a guide by which all HCA students shall conduct themselves. Since young people need to learn and to realize that they are accountable before God for their own behavior and actions, HCA's Code of Conduct is based upon a simple acrostic, **GOD**:

Give the speaker (both teachers and other students), your full attention.

Only use appropriate/kind words to one another as well as about one another.

Don't be a space invader (keep your hands to yourself, remain in your assigned spot).

- <u>I will choose to honor God in all I say and do</u>; I will choose NOT to be a stumbling block to my peers.
- I will come to class prepared with required books and supplies each week. Homework, when assigned, is mandatory. I will seek help from my teacher if I do not understand the material presented in class.
- I will follow all instructions given by teachers, HCA supervisors, and parent assistants.
- I will remain with my parent or teacher during sign-in and sign-out time. I understand that I may not run around the facility during this time period.
- I will not enter or leave the building unless escorted by a parent or authorized person.
- I will remain in my designated classroom or lunch area.
- I will WALK at all times while in the HCA building, except during P.E. or lunch.
- I will respect the property of Cornerstone and HCA teachers, parents, and other students.
- I will abide by HCA's Dress Code in the HCA Handbook.
- I understand that I must be supervised by an adult at all times while at HCA.
- If I should have a conflict or feel uncomfortable with a fellow student or adult at HCA that I am unable to resolve, I will seek the help of a teacher, supervisor, parent helper, or HCA administrator to help resolve the problem.
- I have reviewed HCA's discipline policy in HCA's Handbook and the consequences that will result if I do not abide by HCA's rules and policies.
